Body Language Volume 14 By (Get Physical)





Die letzten Erfolge von Tobi und Simon tragen weitere Früchte. Sie sind die auserkorenen Maestros für die Zusammenstellung von "Body Language" Nummer 14, auf der sie versuchen Lounge Beats mit nächtlichen Feierattacken zu verbinden. Daher startet die Compilation mit Gold Panda, Maribou State dreamy und moody und nimmt mit minimalen Pattern eines Robag Wrukme leicht an Fahrt auf. Herrlich, wie die metalloiden Perkussionstabs mit verrauch ten Stimmen interagieren. Nach den smoothen Exponaten von Axel Boman und Ian Pooley, befindet man sich spätestens mit Super Flu im Clubtrim, um sogleich in einen funky Flow umzuschalten ("Optick -Hopasa"). 2 Raumwohnung im andhim Mix, Atjazz und Stereo Total sind weitere Höhepunkte, wobei "Hausch" von andhim selbst den besten Track darstellt (auch wegen der Referenzen zum großartigen "Wine & Chocolate" Mix). Deep Nation (Club Star/Conva)



So, so, belgischer Deep House. Unter diesem Motto firmiert diese Compilation, die Labelchef Henry Kohn compiliert hat. Bis auf Buscemi, Sven Van Hees D'Stephanie sagen mir 72 die restlichen Künstler wenig bis gar nichts. Dennoch zeich net sich ein homogenes Bild ab, das in sich etwas changiert (Rawdio würde ich trotz Synthiechords nicht unbedingt als Deep House bezeichnen). Für den Mix der zweite Seite ist Pat Lezizmo verantwortlich, der härter einsteigt und etwas dicker rollt (Beazar – "I-Cloud"). Auch das ist stimmig und gut hörbar und an netten Abenden begleitend einsetzbar. Für exaltiertes Partyvergnügen muss man aber auf andere Tonträger setzen. ____ Cars10.Becker

Fabric 74: Move D



David Moufang hat ein weites Spektrum an musikalischen Einflüssen und Produktionen aufzuweisen, das von Jazz über Soul zu Electronica und House reicht. Auf Fabric Nummer 74 offenhart er uns seine Liebe zu House und startet zunächst dick in Form von Roy Davis Junior, der mit einem geloopten deepen Pianoton, bereits den Weg für Kommendes ebnet: Liz Torres läutet die vocalbetonten Tracks ein, die sich über Liberty City und Jamie Trench fortsetzen Amerikanischer House mit pum pender Rhythmik steht hier bei ihm im Focus (Earl Jeffers, MD III oder Darkman aka DJ Pierre auf Strictly Rhythm). Stärker bewer-te ich die Midtemponummern mit funky Appeal ("Move D – Luvbyrds" oder "Willow – Feel Me"). Fabric 75: Maja Jane Coles

(Fabric)

Zugegebenermaßen gehört Maja zu meinen Lieblingsmusikaktivisten und ihr DI Set beim letzten Sonar Festival hat mich beeindruckt. Insofern lag meine Spannung angesichts der 75. Fabric Ausgabe, die von ihr



gehostet wird, auf Höchstlevel Und sie enttäuscht gewährten Vorschusslorbeeren nicht. Ihr harter, perkussiver Mix entfaltet volle Wirkung und die melodiösen Momente legen die emotionale Reife dieser außergewöhnlichen Künstlerin dar. Stellvertretend möchte ich Trus'Me und Ksky herausgreifen, die die oben genann-ten Attribute perfekt erfüllen. Ansonsten begegnen uns auf der Wanderschaft deepe Chords und harte Beats von Mathew Johnson (kongenialer Mix von Dixon zu "Level 7"), Paul Woodford, DJ Yellow, Dapayk & Padberg, Yenk und Heiko Laux mit Mixen von Edu Imbernon, Ripperton oder Dense & Pika. Das hat Drive, Biss und Tiefgang und geht sofort auf Rotation Danke Maja! ___ Cars10



Eine lange Tradition verbindet Fabric (Club) mit Jack Beats, dem kongenialen DJ Duo, bestehend aus Niall Dailly und Ben Geffin. In ihren DI-Nächten als Fabric Residents verstanden sie sich von Anfang an als ein Melting Pot von Musik, als Speerspitze der ganz frühen Raveszene. Das drückt sich in ihrer Musik, insbesondere in diesem Mix aus, auch heute noch aus. Hier finden sich die Kracher von Ten Walls ("Requiem"), Duke Dumont ("Street Walker") oder UZ auf Boysnoize. Wohl kaum ein Track verkörpert das Musikverständnis des Duo's mit harten, elektroiden Beats mit urbanem Streetfeel besser aus als P Money mit "Round The Clock im Cause & Affect Remix". Hier fliegen die Raveseguenzen unterstützt von harten Beats mit gerappten Passagen. Völlig irre und steil geht schließlich Destructo. Die Tommy Trash Version von "Higher" Wahnsinn kaum zu überbieten, legt für den ausrastenden Fan im Break aber auch mal eine Pause ein. Fünfzehn Künstler, fünfzehn Titel. Alle hinterlassen sie Fußabdrücke, die unterschiedlich ausgeprägt sind. Gemein sind ihnen afrikanische Wurzeln, die das rhythmische und melodische Fundament bil-den. Jazz, Afro, Hip Hop, House oder Brass – alles ist vertreten. Es beginnt mit dem 15köpfigen Pauken und Trompeten Orchester Angel City All Star Brass Band, geht über Hip Hop House von Bad Jazz Troup zu jazzigen Broken Be (Karl Hector). Abkühlung hält Romanowski mit Raps über Downbeats und sanftem R'N'B sowie die lasziven Beats von Lipanti-Rodrigez bereit. Gegen Ende zieht das Tempo nochmals an, wenn Mr. Chop im Stile von Pulp Fiction Styles oder Fort Knox Five perkussiv feuern. 

Analoge Leidenschaft in dunklen Räumen

Ornaments bringt eine wahrlich opulente Remixsammlung zum letztjährigen youAND:THEMACHINES-Album "Behind" auf den Markt. Künstler wie Matthew Herbert, XDB, Legowelt, Basic Soul Unit, Steve Bug, Freund der Familie, Boo Williams und viele weitere haben sich der Stücke des Projekts von Martin Müller angenommen. Das Ganze erscheint als limitiertes, handbemaltes Dreifachvinyl und als ebenso limitierte und handbemalte Kassette.

Hallo Martin, welche Idee steht hinter vouAND:THEMACHINES?

Das ist sozusagen mein Soloprojekt mit den Maschinen in meiner dunklen Kammer (lacht). Unter diesem Namen erschien im letzten Sommer mein Album "Behind" auf Ornaments, von dem eben jetzt ein Remixalbum veröffentlicht wird. Normalerweise liegt unser Fokus ja auf youANDme, bei dem Daniel (Ströter) und ich uns musikalisch austoben. Da Daniel aber unter der Woche als Architekt arbeitet, hat er nur noch wenig Zeit fürs Studio. Deswegen habe ich das Album alleine produziert. Weil ich nicht ganz von youANDme wegrücken wollte und fast alle Sounds mit alten Maschinen eingespielt habe, lag der Name youAND:THEMACHINES nahe.

Welche Maschinen sind charakteristisch für das Projekt?

Seit vielen Jahren sammle ich alte Drum Machines, Synthesizer und Effektgeräte. Ein großer Vorteil ist, dass man sofort einen schönen, warmen Grundsound hat und vor allem ist die Interaktion mit einem "richtigen" Instrument viel direkter, als wenn man alles mit der Computermaus macht. Ich nehme meistens lange Jams mit dem Rechner auf und nutze diesen eigentlich nur für das finale Arrangement. Diese Arbeitsweise ist ziemlich schnell, macht mehr Spaß und hat sich für mich über die Jahre als am besten herausgestellt.

Was ist dein Anspruch an dich als Produzent?

Ich versuche, wirklich jedes einzelne Element selbst zu machen und keine Samples oder Presets zu benutzen. Das dauert natürlich länger und ist schwieriger, als mal eben ein paar fertige Loops aus der neuesten Sample Library zusammenzuschieben, aber man bekommt einen viel persönlicheren Sound und kann eine eigene Handschrift entwickeln.

Welche Künstler waren prägend für deine musikalische Entwicklung?

Da gibt es eigentlich drei verschiedene, die wahrscheinlich meine Musik am meisten geprägt haben. Ich bin ein großer Fan von Matthew Herbert, da er es wirklich geschafft hat, unglaubliche Sachen durch die verschiedensten Ansätze zu realisieren. Dabei verpackt er auch noch durchaus kritische Botschaften in seiner Kunst. Ich habe mich sehr gefreut, dass er jetzt für das "Behind"-Remixalbum eine Version von meiner Nummer "Uncover" mit der Stimme von Delhia De France angefertigt hat. Carl Craig ist ein weiterer Künstler, dessen Musik ich meistens ziemlich gut finde. Die Klangqualität seiner Produktionen begeistert mich immer wieder aufs Neue und ich kenne kaum jemanden, der da herankommt. Die dubbigen Einflüsse kommen bei mir hauptsächlich aus den alten Basic Channel oder Rhythm & Sound-Sachen, die einfach zeitlos sind und die ich auch heute noch gerne höre. Mark Ernestus und Moritz von Oswald haben in den Neunzigern nicht nur einen eigenen Stil erschaffen, sondern sie haben dort auch so ziemlich alles gesagt und fast nichts kam da jemals wieder ran.

Welche Kriterien waren bei der Auswahl der Remixer entscheidend und warum ist es eigentlich eine so große Zahl an Bearbeitungen geworden?

Ich habe mir gewünscht, dass es von jedem "Behind"-Albumtrack eine neue Version gibt, und deshalb ist es eine etwas größere Schar an Remixen geworden. Es ist natürlich ein Risiko, da man bei so vielen verschiedenen Produzenten vorher nicht weiß, ob das Ganze am Ende zusammen passt und als Album funktioniert, aber zum Glück ist es ein sehr homogenes Gesamtwerk geworden und ich bin echt glücklich darüber. Bei der Auswahl der Remixer war ich entweder Fan von den Produktionen, oder es waren Freunde, bei denen ich sehr neugierig war, was dabei heraus kommen würde. Ich fand es auch wichtig, dass es erneut eine 3-fach Vinyl LP gibt, wo ich wieder die 333-Cover selbst bemalt habe. Das hat zwar mehrere Wochen gedauert, aber dafür hat man dann ein tolles Produkt, was man so nicht downloaden kann.

Welcher der Remixe hat für dich eine besondere Bedeutung und warum?

Das ist natürlich eine fiese Frage (lacht), weil man dann einen hervorheben muss. Ich hab mich über jeden Einzelnen gefreut, und es war keiner dabei, der enttäuscht hat. Meistens ist es ja so, dass man bei jedem Hören einen anderen Favoriten hat, was ja auch immer von der Stimmung abhängig ist. Auf der ersten Platte sind sehr dubbige Versionen vom Freund der Familie, XDB, Basic Soul Unit, Youandewan oder auch die erste gemeinsame Produktion von Marko Fürstenberg und Luke Hess auf der Achse Leipzig/Detroit. Kosta XDB war damals, als ich in meiner Jugend anfing Platten zu kaufen, der Einkäufer für Techno und House bei DIS Records in Göttingen. Er hatte da schon einen ausgezeichneten Geschmack und im Laden fand man eine gute, kleine Auswahl von Sachen wie Robert Hood, Underground Resistance oder auch Basic Channel, die mich schon in eine bestimmte Richtung geführt haben. Somit habe ich mich über seine Zusage sehr gefreut, denn damit schließt sich auch wieder ein Kreis. Die zweite Scheibe startet mit einem Steve Bug Edit von "Drift" und dann haben Rising Sun und The Analog Roland Orchestra meinen Pianotrack "Desire" auf unterschiedliche Weise interpretiert. Die C-Seite führt direkt nach Chicago mit Boo Williams und Jamie 3:26. Mit Matthew Herbert in bester Wishmountain-Laune startet die letzte Platte, gefolgt von einem groovigen Sascha Dive, einen düsteren Technobanger von Legowelt, einen für Daniel ungewöhnlich deepen you-ANDme Remix und dem orchestralen Closer von Carlos Nilmmns.

Die "Behind Reshaped" ist unter anderem auch auf Kassette erschienen. Zollst du damit der Tatsache Tribut, dass derzeit immer mehr Label spezielle Editionen oder Sublabels auf Tape herausbringen?

Wenn ich ehrlich bin, habe ich bisher kaum etwas mitbekommen von einer Renaissance der Tapes, verfolge das aber auch nicht bewusst. Für mich ist die Kassette das Medium meiner Jugend, und ich hab damals fast jede Radiosendung mit elektronischer Musik mitgeschnitten. Bei uns war die HR3 Clubnight ganz groß und ich kenne viele Künstler, die durch diese Sendung erst zur elektronischen Musik gekommen sind. Damals gab es ja kein Internet und für viele war die Sendung auf dem Land die einzige Möglichkeit an diese Musik zu kommen. Da alle Remixe von der Spielzeit nicht auf CD gepasst hätten und ich wegen meiner Jugend auch unbedingt mal ein Tape veröffentlichen wollte, haben wir von dem Remixalbum eine spezielle Kassettenversion gemacht, die einen extra Remix vom Freund der Familie enthält, der nicht auf Vinyl ist. Es gibt 150 Stück mit handbemalten Covern und ich habe keine Ahnung, ob das 2014 noch jemanden interessiert (lacht).








YOUAND: THEMACHINES





Hi Martin, how are you a few days after the release of Behind LP Reshaped?

Hello Florian, I'm fine. Thank you! The release is out now and i'm really happy with the result. It was a lot of work to finish this album because it has handmade packaging. I painted every album cover, all hand-painted on limited vinyl and the tape edition. It took more then 2 months and this much work is the reason to limit the vinyl edition to a special number of 333 and the tape edition to 150. I dedicated the same effort for the original album last year with black colour on a white background and now its inverted with white colour on a black background. For me it's the perfect way to close the story of my first solo album project and I think to invest so much work into the packaging makes the album a little bit more personal and it's something you can't download in the digital age.

This last LP, Behind Reshaped, is an opulent collection of selected remixes of your first album, Behind, done by internationally respected electronic producers. How did it happen? Who came on to whom?

I'm really thankful that so many of my favorite producers did rework an album track including the likes of Matthew Herbert, Steve Bug, XDB, Boo Williams, Sascha Dive, Legowelt, Marko Fürstenberg & Luke Hess, The Analog Roland Orchestra, Carlos Nilmmns, Freund der Familie, Basic Soul Unit, Youandewan, Rising Sun, Jamie 3:26 and youANDme (Daniel). After the release of my album "BEHIND" in June last year I had the wish that every album track will get the remix treatment. So I asked some producers who I really love, respect and who have inspired me to make my own music.

Behind the "Freund der Familie" is Klaus Rakete and Mirko Hunger. I think they did the artist project and label since 2007 and i`m a big fan of their deep and dub inspired sound. You could hear the love and passion if you check their productions and live sets.

What's you favorite remix in this LP and why?

I think its really hard to choose a favourite because it depends always on your mood and at which time of the day you are listening to but I can say that i'm really happy with every remix and there was no version which disappoints me.

For those who do not know you, could you name a track (one of yours or of another artist) that represents you?

Wow, this is a really hard question because I love so many different styles of music like house, techno, electronica, ambient, dub-techno, downbeats but I'm also interested in classical stuff, jazz, soul or funk music. I'm all the time hungry for new sounds and influences. One track which has many different waves is "Beyond" from my album "BEHIND". It starts with some really deep and sad minor pads and in the middle its changing into some euphoric Detroit inspired techno. At the end you could find a smooth "ambient-string-surprise" which was played by Olga Kholodnaia. Maybe this one reflects my different passions the best at the moment.



You're the man behind you ANDme, Dubsuite and you AND: THEMACHINES. How each of them reflect your personality?

youANDme is the music project of Daniel and I. We lived together in a flat with 2 studios for more than 10 years and this was a really inspiring time. In 2008 we created the youANDme project and its still our main priority. Daniel is focussing on his career as an architect now and thats why he has not as much time for studio work at the moment. That's the reason we both decided that I do the album production as solo project under the new name youAND:THEMACHINES. At first it was a foreign feeling but then I realized more and more that I have the freedom to express myself in a more personal way. It was great to make music alone and I think the result is different from our other works. When I finished the "BEHIND" LP I was happy that Daniel really liked the result. Dubsuite was a project with my old friend Holger Flinsch and we released a "modular-experimental-ambient-dub" album called "Eigenleben" on the Stadtgruen label in 2006.



Do you have other upcomings projects?

We are working on some new **youANDme** EPs and there is the plan for a new album of youANDme. We finished some remixes and one of them is for Steve Bug which will be out soon as Pokerflat 150. It's a big pleasure to remix the label boss for the 150 anniversary release and we are happy with the result.



Berlin is described historically as THE city of techno, like the Detroit of Europe. What about now, in 2014 ? Do your city influence your music?

I'm not sure if it's really Berlin which inspired us most. Sure it's maybe the best place to go out to techno clubs and have never ending parties but the city could give you so much more. There are really nice theaters, jazz clubs, parks, restaurants, bars and galleries outside of the tourists places which are not so overhyped and its always fun to discover something new and get inspiration behind the (techno-) music biz. We like the vibe in the summer months but the dark and cold winters could be a little bit depressing sometimes and this is a good reason to spend the most time in the studio and jamming with the machines.

Could you describe one of your typical days?

At 9 o`clock I go to the office and do the typical label work. This means I'm writing e-mails, doing phone calls, preparing artworks, doing paper stuff, updating websites... It's sometimes the best part and sometimes the most boring part of the day. After I finished my job in the office I go to the studio and try to work on new stuff or I have to finish the track with the deadline from last week. During the afternoon I need to free my eyes from screens and I go jogging in the park with some friends. It's good to free your mind from all this business stuff. After dinner I go again to the studio because I love the magic vibe during the night. For me its often the time where I got the best ideas.

Do you ever come in France? to play? to travel?

Yes I played 4 times in Paris at really different parties but I have only good memories. Everytime there is always a really friendly vibe and the people had an open mind for all kinds of music. I did also a nice road-trip with my girl friend to the south of france some years ago. This was one of my best holidays because you have a really beautiful countryside, awesome food and a lot of sun.

What you do you think about the evolution of electronic music since you were born? What about the future of electronic music?

Sometimes you listen to the first techno and house records from the 80ies and you think there was no evolution until today and this pioneers of electronic music said everything in the beginning. At other days you discover the fresh music of an 18 years old kid and it blows you away and you get this revolutionary feeling from your youth which totally kicks you again. I don't know what the future of electronic music is about. I hope somebody will create a completely new interesting style which will change everything but I don't know if it's possible.


Do you want to talk about someone special or something special in your life, something you like or dislike?

We will play a lot of club and festivals gigs during the summer. Besides all the touring we will work on the first ideas for a new album and I hope we will find enough time to enjoy life, sun and beaches.



Martin, wie ist euer Projekt eigentlich mal entstanden und was waren Höhepunkte?

youANDme ist ein Projekt von Daniel und mir, das seit 2008 existiert. Wir legen unter diesem Namen auf, produzieren Platten und betreiben auch mehrere Labels. Höhepunkte gab es sicher viele und es ist schwer da welche herauszupicken. Es ist ein bisschen deeper und dubbiger als unsere gemeinsamen Sachen und eignet sich sowohl für den Club als auch für zu Hause. Da ich alles selber mit alten Maschinen eingespielt habe und ich nicht ganz von unserem gemeinsamen Projekt abrücken wollte, lag der Name youAND:THEMACHINES nah.

Jetzt kam ja gerade das Remixalbum zu deiner "BEHIND" LP raus. Wer ist alles dabei und wie kam es zu der Idee?

Ich hab mir gewünscht, dass es von jedem Track einen Remix gibt und deshalb gibt es das Ganze auch wieder als 3-fach Vinyl, wo ich wie beim Original jedes Cover in einer limitierten Auflage selber bemalt habe. Dabei sind viele alte Helden und einige Freunde von mir wie z.B. Matthew Herbert, Steve Bug, Boo Williams, XDB, Legowelt, Basic Soul Unit, Sascha Dive, Luke Hess & Marko Fürstenberg u.a.

Was steht als nächstes bei youANDme an?

Im Juni kommt die Pokerflat 150 raus, wo ein Remix von uns für Steve Bug dabei ist. Im Moment arbeiten wir gerade an verschiedenen eigenen Sachen, die dann im Herbst veröffentlicht werden. Jetzt freuen wir uns erstmal auf die Sommersaison mit vielen Festivals und Open Airs.

Auf was können wir uns im "Bordel" am 19. Juni in der Fiesen Remise freuen?

Auf ein grooviges Set mit einigen deepen Einflüssen, mal jackend, mal techiger, mal housiger und sicher auch mit einigen unveröffentlichten Sachen von uns. Ich freu mich!

Dark Side Of The Vinyl

Wo sollte man geravet haben, macht EDM elektronische Musik kaputt und ist es billiger seine Vinylcovers selbst zu bemalen? You And The Machines liefern überraschende Antworten.




youAND:THEMACHINES haben die Kunst der originellen Groß-Kleinschreibung perfektioniert. You And The Machines ist aber auch das Soloprojekt von Martin Müller, besser bekannt als eine Hälfte des Berliner DJ-Duos You And Me. Knapp ein Jahr nachdem Martins Debüt "Behind" ohne me, dafür aber mit Machines auf Ornaments das Licht der Nacht erblickte, erschien ein vollgepacktes "Reshape" mit Remixen von Steve Bug über Legowelt bis hin zu Brothers' Vibe.



Im Interview erzählt Martin dass DIY-Artwork eigentlich nicht billig ist, welcher Kollege ihm ein Weihnachtsgeschenk gemacht hat und wo er am liebsten feiert.



Für gewöhnlich erscheint nach einem Album eine Remix-EP. Du hast dich jedoch dazu entschieden eine 3-fach 12" zu machen mit einer irren Anzahl von Künstlern. War es schwierig alle zu kontaktieren und sie davon zu überzeugen bei dem Projekt mitzumachen?



Als ich mein Album "Behind" im Frühjahr 2013 fertig hatte, entstand der Wunsch von jedem Albumtrack einen Remix machen zu lassen. Ich fand es spannend, dass einige Künstler die mich zum Musik machen inspiriert haben, mein erstes eigenes Album neu interpretieren. Somit schließt sich da wieder ein Kreis. Außerdem ist es jedes Mal interessant zu sehen, wie andere Musiker mit deinen Sounds und Ideen arbeiten.

Auch bei der Gestaltung des Covers war es mir wichtig eine persönliche Note mit reinzubekommen und dafür hab ich jedes einzelne Sleeve der "Behind" 3-fach Vinyl-Edition selber mit schwarzer Farbe auf weißen Hintergrund bemalt. Deshalb bot es sich an, das Remix-Album auch wieder als 3-fach Vinyl mit





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handbemalten Cover herauszubringen. Diesmal hab ich die Farben invertiert und mit weißer Farbe auf schwarzen Hintergrund gemalt. Somit passen beide Editionen auch optisch prima zusammen.

Wie war die Herangehensweise bei den einzelnen Remixen? Samples und Stems verschicken und einfach mal warten was passiert? Oder gab es doch Auflagen und Absagen?

Angefragt hab ich entweder "musikalische Helden" von mir oder Freunde, die zu der Art der Musik des Albums gepasst haben. Eigentlich war der ganze Prozess relativ entspannt und fast alle, die auf meiner Wunschliste standen, haben sofort zugesagt. Bei einigen Nummern wusste ich sofort, wer vom Stil gut dazu passen könnte. Bei anderen sind die Künstler an mich herangetreten, da sie zum Beispiel eine Stimme vom Album richtig toll fanden und schon eine Idee im Kopf hatten.

Die einzige Auflage war eigentlich die Länge der Remixe, damit alles auch auf Vinyl passt und noch ordentlich klingt. Ansonsten konnte sich jeder austoben und ich hab mich von den Ergebnissen überraschen lassen, mit denen ich jetzt richtig glücklich bin.

Welcher der 15 Artists war am schnellsten überzeugt und wer hat am Längsten auf sich warten lassen?

Da ich selber extreme Deadlines bei Remixen hasse, hab ich dieses Projekt ohne Stress und Druck geplant und insgesamt war fast ein halbes Jahr Zeit. So kann man auch mal die Nummer liegen lassen und ein paar Wochen später mit frischen Ohren weitermachen. Durch den langen Zeitraum hat keiner die Abgabe Ende 2013 überschritten. Matthew Herbert hat seinen Remix zum Beispiel Heiligabend um 18.00 Uhr geschickt und das war natürlich ein tolles Weihnachtsgeschenk.


Was war generell die größte Herausforderung bei diesem Projekt für dich?

Am Anfang hatte ich ein wenig Angst, dass die Idee von einem ganzen Album mit neuen Interpretationen meiner Songs nicht aufgeht, weil die Nummern zu verschieden sein könnten – oder dass ich einfach keine schlüssige Reihenfolge hinbekomme, die dann auch als Album funktioniert. Man weiß ja bei Remixen nie was man am Ende geschickt bekommt und das ist schon so eine Art Wundertüte.









Zum Glück haben sich die Befürchtungen nicht erfüllt und es ist ein schlüssiges Gesamtwerk geworden, was wunderbar zusammenpasst und auch Spaß macht am Stück zu hören.

Du bist scheinbar ein sehr handwerklicher Mensch. Neben der Vorliebe für analoges Equipment, hast du die Cover deines Album "Behind", aber auch jenes des Reshape, in einer limitierten Auflage von 333 Stück selbst gemalt. Besteht für dich der Reiz darin etwas mit den eigenen Händen zu schaffen oder ist es DIY auch einfach billiger?

Nein, billiger war das leider nicht, eher das Gegenteil (*lacht*). Für mein erstes Soloalbum wollte ich auf jeden Fall eine besondere Verpackung, die auch noch etwas Persönliches hat und die Idee mit dem selber Bemalen hatte ich schon seit einigen Jahren. Ich bin ja selber auch ein leidenschaftlicher Plattensammler und freue mich jedes Mal, wenn ich besondere Verpackungen oder Sammlereditionen finde. Von daher lag es nahe, dass ich jedes Cover von der Original-LP und den Remixen selber bemale und es somit praktisch ein Unikat ist.

Es wird ja viel geraunzt über EDM-Kultur und wie elektronische Megaspektakel die klassische Clubkultur kaputt machen. Bist auch einer von denen?

Naja, ich kann dieser ganzen EDM-Welle gar nichts abgewinnen. Für mich klingt das wie schlecht aufgewärmter 90er Jahre-Trance. Aber die Amis feiern das gerade, als ob sie das Rad neu erfunden hätten.

Ich war auch gerade drüben in New York und habe gespielt. Man merkt, dass neben dem ganzen Mainstream auch ein riesiges Interesse für Underground-Sounds herrscht. Vielleicht hat dann die EDM-Welle auch etwas Gutes und einige Leute stoßen darüber auf qualitativ höherwertige elektronische Musik.

Wie stehst du zu Soundcloud? Dein Album steht ja ganz drauf, andrerseits wandern auch einige von dort ab ...



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Es ist immer spannend mit solchen Legenden zu arbeiten und zu sehen, wie sie ihre Sachen realisieren. Robert ist ein so begnadeter Musiker und alles lief super professionell ab.

Ich hab ihm mein Instrumental und meine Ideen für Vocals geschickt und innerhalb von wenigen Tagen hatte ich über 15 Gesangsspuren im Postfach. Ich glaub ich hab noch nie so perfekt aufgenommene Vocals gehabt und es war ein großer Spaß, damit den Song zu beenden.

Wo sollte man deiner Meinung nach unbedingt mal geravet haben?

Es klingt ein wenig abgedroschen, aber das Berghain ist immer noch einer der besonderen Plätze auf dieser Welt. Außerdem sind die Partys bei unseren Freunden von Origami in Venedig jedes Mal der Wahnsinn. Die Fusion und Kazantip Republic sind meine beiden liebsten Festivals und wenn man auf Ibiza ist, findet man die beste Musik bei Kehakuma im Space.

Was hast du musikalisch in den nächsten zwölf Monaten geplant und wann kann man dich in Österreich hören?

Jetzt gerade wurde die Poker Flat 150 von Steve Bug und einem youANDme Remix veröffentlicht. Im Herbst kommt dann eine große Compilation zum 15-jährigen Bestehen von Poker Flat mit einer Nummer von uns raus. Außerdem arbeiten wir gerade an einigen Remixen und an zwei neuen youANDme Platten.

In Österreich sind wir wieder am 23.8. in Wien in der Grellen Forelle, wo wir uns schon riesig drauf freuen.

youANDme are a Berlin based production duo made up of Daniel Ströter and Martin Müller. They've been producing together for the past 15 years and have remixed the likes of Moodymann, Radio Slave, Seth Troxler, Lawrence and many others. In June 2013 Martin Müller released his first solo album "Behind" through the Ornaments imprint, a year later he returns with "Behind LP Reshaped" an opulent collection of edits, interpretations and remixes featuring XDB, Freund der Familie, Marko Furstenberg & Luke Hess, Basic Soul Unit, Matthew Herbert, Legowelt and many more. To celebrate the release we invited Martin to record a two hour dub techno mix, plus compile his top 10 dub techno tracks.

HI MARTIN. THANKS FOR RECORDING THIS STUNNING DUB TECHNO MIX FOR INVERTED AUDIO. COULD YOU START OFF BY TELLING US A BIT MORE ABOUT THE MIX, HOW IT WAS MADE, YOUR TRACK SELECTION AS WELL AS YOUR ADORATION FOR DUB TECHNO?

I recorded this mix live at Studio R in Berlin. It's a nice and dark studio which has a good sound system in the basement of the club. There is a smokey, dubby vibe going on and you have no neighbours complaining about the loudness of the bass. For example the guy above my flat start to jump like hell when I put the music on at home. No idea if he's dancing though maybe he really loves my beats or maybe he hates it!

The set is a little bit deeper than our normal club sets. I selected some of my all-time favourite dubtechno records and also some new stuff like the remix of Marko Fuerstenberg & Luke Hess (under their new moniker DUEL) for my album the track I produced called "The Veil" feat. Keter Darker.

My love for dub-inspired stuff came from the first Rhythm & Sound records which are produced by Mark Ernestus and Moritz von Oswald. I also used some music from these two innovators in the mix.

HOW DID YOU MEET CO-PRODUCER DANIEL STRÖTER? WHAT WAS IT THAT PROVOKED YOU TO START MAKING MUSIC TOGETHER?

We met 15 years ago in our old hometown. I was a DJ and Daniel had a groovebox and this is when we tried to produce our first tracks. We taught each other and Daniel began to buy records and I started to buy my first analogue gear.

When we moved to Berlin we shared a flat with 2 studios for more then 10 years. Our early influences came from a club in Kassel / Germany which was called "Stammheim". They had a really amazing techno floor where great artists played every weekend with highlights such as Jeff Mills, Christian Vogel, Pierre, Super Collider LIVE, Matthew Herbert, Sven Väth, Claude Young, Ben Sims, Derrick May and much more.

AS A PRODUCTION DUO HOW DO THE TWO OF YOU BALANCE THE WORK LOAD? DO YOU OPERATE TOGETHER AS ONE, OR DOES THE OTHER PLAY A SPECIFIC ROLE IN THE MUSIC MAKING PROCESS?

Each of us have our own studio nowadays. We send our ideas through Skype and talk about it, or we meet up to finish a track. Both our studios have similar gear so it's really easy to get the right workflow in both studios so we can jam effectively with the machines.

TELL ME ABOUT YOUR PERSONAL MUSICAL HERITAGE. WHAT'S YOUR FIRST MEMORY OF MUSIC AND WHAT DID YOU GROW UP LISTENING TO?

That's a good question. If I think back to the earliest music I can remember the first thing would be Michael Jackson and his album "Thriller". My favourite tracks were "<u>Billie Jean</u>" and "<u>Beat It</u>" because both are so funky and have these great basslines.

I was born and raised in East Germany and when the wall came down I was 8 years old. It was really hard to get music from the West but Michael Jackson was one of the few pop-stars which we had on vinyl and tape. Later I got my first techno and house lessons from a radio show called "Clubnight" where great DJs like Sven Väth or Pierre played regular. I was living in a small village in the countryside and the radio show was the only possibility to discover new and fresh sounds. It was the early nineties and there was no internet with Soundcloud etc. The only chance was to record everything on tape and listen to it again and again.

YOU'VE ALSO WORKED A LOT OF REMIXES FOR THE LIKES OF MOODYMANN, RADIO SLAVE, SETH TROXLER, LAWRENCE, BROTHERS VIBE, ROBERT OWENS, TIMO MAAS, PAUL JOHNSON, MARK BROOM, KOLLEKTIV TURMSTRASSE, JOHANNES HEIL, FLORIAN MEINDL, PASCAL FEOS OR PIRUPA. CAN YOU DIVULGE YOUR APPROACH TO THE ART OF REMIXING, WHAT'S YOUR PROCESS AND HAVE YOU DISCOVERED A TRIED AND TESTED FORMULA?

Its always fun to do remixes and edits because you can learn a lot if you listen carefully. It's nice to see how other producers work too. If we do a remix then there has to be at least three or four really good elements or a great vocal which catches us. We always try not to use a typical formula in our productions to keep things more interesting. Maybe it's easier to copy a successful formula again and again but this would be to boring for us.

The last remix we did for Steve Bug called '<u>Pelican Glide</u>' and it will be released this month as <u>Pokerflat 150</u>. He had some amazing synths inside and it was so much fun to built up our stuff around it.

HOW DID YOU GET INVOLVED WITH THE RECORD LABEL ORNAMENTS?

Ornaments is a small group of friends and music lovers and we are involved from the beginning. They try to keep alive the spirit of deep music and vinyl culture apart the newest trends and hypes. I like this attitude a lot.

YOU RECENTLY RELEASED A REMIX COMPILATION CALLED YOUAND: THEMACHINES FEATURING A CHOICE SELECTION OF REMIXES SUCH AS XDB, FREUND DER FAMILIE, MARKO FÜRSTENBERG & LUKE HESS, RISING SUN, MATTHEW HERBERT, LEGOWELT AND MANY MANY MORE. FOR HOW LONG HAS THIS COMPILATION BEEN IN THE WORKS AND WHAT IS THE CONTEXT BEHIND THE COMPILATION?

It was back in June 2013 that my first solo album "<u>Behind</u>" was released through Ornaments. I had a wish that there would be a remix of each album track and now a year on, this remix album is called "<u>Behind LP Reshaped</u>". It's an opulent collection of edits, interpretations and remixes. The release is out now and I'm really happy with the result.

It was a lot of work to finish this album because it comes with handmade packaging. I painted every album cover, all hand-painted on limited vinyl and also on the tape edition. It took more then 2 months and this much work is the reason to limit the vinyl edition to a special number of 333 and the tape edition to 150.

I dedicated the same effort for the original album last year with black colour on a white background and now it's inverted with white colour on a black background. For me it's the perfect way to close the story of my first solo album project and I think to invest so much work into the packaging makes the album a little bit more personal and it's something you can't download in the digital age.

WHAT WAS YOUR SELECTION PROCESS IN ACQUIRING ARTISTS TO CREATE REMIXES FOR THE COMPILATION? WAS IT A CASE OF ASKING FRIENDS, OR ARE THERE ARTISTS YOU'VE NEVER MET IN PERSON FEATURED ON THE COMPILATION?

I'm really thankful that so many of my favourite artists did rework an album track. Some guys are good friends of mine and I love their stuff and some guys are producers who have inspired me to make my own music.

BEING BASED IN BERLIN, WHICH OTHER MUSICIANS DO YOU TEND TO HANG OUT WITH THE MOST?

I spend a lot of time with Michal (aka The Analog Roland Orchestra) and Marco (aka Rhauder). We share the same love for gear and its always interesting to talk about the newest stuff, tips & tricks. It's also nice to hang out with friends outside of the music scene to participate to other aspects of life.

TELL ME ABOUT YOUR STUDIO, YOUR SETUP, SECRET WEAPONS FOR PRODUCING PARTICULAR SOUNDS AND ANY OTHER OUT-THERE INSTRUMENTS.

Most of the times I use the computer only as a recording device. I record long takes of my outboard gear and then I cut the best parts and arrange it in the DAW. I know it's really nerdy and maybe you could do the same with software but I think the interaction with a machine is different. You come up with ideas faster and you get a more human touch if you play everything in realtime. I like to work in this way. Some of my favourite gear is the Jupiter 6, Moog Voyager, Alpha Juno 2, Prophet 12, Tempest and the newest member in the family is the MFB Tanzbär.

ARE YOUR PRODUCTIONS INFLUENCED BY PARTICULAR ENVIRONMENTS, LIFE EXPERIENCES OR TRAVELS?

Everything that surrounds you can stimulate your thoughts and your music. For me the biggest inspiration is to travel and to discover many different cultures. I love art, nature, good food, to read books, to go to concerts and to listen to other music than house and techno. I think if you keep your mind wide open for new things it will be a great inspiration for your productions. One of my dreams is to produce an ambient album in a small lonely house on the beach of the Baltic Sea during the autumn months. It would be great to look out of the window and see the stormy sea and catch this mood in the music. It's just a dream but I hope one day it will be true.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR THE REST OF THE YEAR? ANY MORE RELEASES SCHEDULED, TOURS, GIGS IN LONDON ETC?

At the moment we are working on some new EPs and I finished some new youANDme remixes which will be out soon. There are also a lot of club and festival gigs during the summer. Hopefully we will have the possibility to play again in London because it's one of our favourite cities in Europe.

FINALLY ANY WORDS OF WISDOM YOU'D LIKE TO DEPART WITH?

I don't know if I have real words of wisdom but i'm really thankful that I could do what I love and I hope I can continue this way as long as possible. Thanks to all who support our music!

Li vi era davvero un bel techno floor che ospitava grandi artisti ogni weekend, in particolare: Jeff Mills, Christian Vogel, Pierre, Super Collider LIVE, Matthew Herbert, Sven Väth, Claude Young, Ben Sims, Derrick May ed altri.

Il sound della vostra prima release era pesante, poi è lentamente diventato più dolce e groovy. Questo cambiamento rispecchia il vostro background musicale?

Abbiamo iniziato a suonare i primi dischi all'età di 14/15 anni. Era un sound techno raw, percussivo e con tanta energia, e quella era la perfetta colonna sonora per la nostra personale rivoluzione da teenager. Attraverso gli anni abbiamo scoperto tutti i tipi di musica elettronica. I nostri generi preferiti sono Dub Techno, Detroit Techno, Elettronica, Ambient o Downbeats e proviamo a far riflettere queste influenze nelle nostre produzioni. Potete riscontrarlo nei nostri Dj set dove ci piace combinare numerosi stili con varie correnti, in un insieme variegato ed altalenante di emozioni. Secondo noi è molto più interessante così, invece di suonare lo stesso genere per ore senza che nessuno realizzi che stai cambiando traccia.

Ho notato che ponete molta attenzione in ogni dettaglio di ogni suono, è questo tipo di ricerca un punto chiave nella definizione del vostro sound?

Si, forse è uno di quelli. Noi amiamo lavorare sui dettagli e proviamo a manipolare il suono in tanti modi diversi. Le cose migliori avvengono anche con un po' di imprevisto e noi proviamo a catturarlo.

Possiamo parlare di produzione? Credo che i producers possano usare i softwares in diversi modi, da un semplice registratore multitraccia ad un'attrezzatura creativa. Mi piacerebbe sapere in che modo la rivoluzione digitale ha influenzato le vostre creazioni.

Il mondo analogico e quello digitale sono entrambi grandiosi e noi pensiamo che si possano ottenere i migliori risultati usandoli entrambi. La maggior parte delle volte iniziamo ad improvvisare con vecchie drum machines e sintetizzatori provenienti dagli anni '80, registrando quello che avviene con le moderne tecniche del 2014. Tagliamo ed arrangiamo tutto col computer. Al termine mandiamo le tracce ad un mixer analogico per il mixdown finale. Questo è il nostro tipico modo di produrre una traccia.

E per quanto riguarda l'approccio ai remix?

E' sempre divertente creare remix e versioni speciali per i nostri dj set. Si può imparare tanto se si ascolta attentamente ed è piacevole vedere come lavorano altri producers. Se decidiamo di fare un remix ci devono stare almeno 3 – 4 ottimi elementi o una grande parte vocale che ci catturano. Oggi abbiamo concluso un nuovo remix per Steve Bug che contiene alcuni synth fantastici. E' stato molto divertente costruirci la nostra musica intorno.

Da dj, c'è qualche club, festival o situazione che vi ispira maggiormente? Se no, quando vi sentite davvero ispirati come dj?

La cosa che ci ispira di più è suonare al Panoramabar a Berlino, perché lì puoi scavare molto in profondità col sound e le persone ti capiscono perfettamente. Il sound system è fantastico e l'atmosfera è sempre qualcosa di speciale.

Scegliete i dischi da portare con voi appena prima dell'esibizione? Esiste un modo specifico che vi fa decidere che tracce suonerete?

Noi prepariamo sempre la nostra borsa di dischi prima dell'esibizione. I dischi che mettiamo dentro alla borsa cambiano a seconda di quanto tempo dovremmo suonare, a che ora della notte suoneremo, se è un grande festival o un'esibizione in un piccolo club. Penso comunque che a casa bisogna fare del lavoro differente, che cambia se si suona per un'ora e mezza durante il picco del festival oppure in un after per 5 ore. Cosa suoniamo dipende dal pubblico, dall'atmosfera, dall'energia e dal giusto momento.





Noi amiamo i vinili perché siamo cresciuti con questa cultura. Per l'album solista del progetto youAND:THEMACHINES, Martin ha voluto creare un packaging raffinato dando alle versioni in vinile e cassetta un tocco unico. Così ha deciso di dipingere ogni cover in splash art. Ci sono voluti più di 2 mesi ma pensiamo che ne è valso investire così tanto lavoro in quest'opera perché il risultato è qualcosa di speciale. "BEHIND" LP RESHAPE interview 3 @ WIT CLUB MAG (IT)

A long partnership defines the sound typical of **youANDme**, as well as analogue equipment, records and an accurate study of the details, and the improvisation. Their mixture of emotions express itself with various styles and genres, keeped together with cohesion of sounds and melodies. Close to German's Klub Kulture their spontaneous approch to music writing brings them in these years to reflect some evolutions, that prove a great research and a unique touch.

Hello Martin, hello Daniel, I would like to start with a simple question. Is the project youANDme started some time before your first release date? How long did you play music together?

We met 15 years ago in our old hometown. At the time when Martin began to Dj Daniel had a groovebox and this is when we tried to produce our first tracks. We taught each other and Daniel began to buy records and Martin started to buy his first analogue gear. When we moved to Berlin we shared a flat with 2 studios for more then 10 years. Our early influences came from a club in Kassel, Germany which was called "Stammheim". There was a really good techno floor where great artists played every weekend with highlights like Jeff Mills, Christian Vogel, Pierre, Super Collider LIVE, Matthew Herbert, Sven Väth, Claude Young, Ben Sims, Derrick May and more.

The sound of the first release was strong, than it slowly became more groovy and sweet. Does it reflect your musical background?

We started to play the first records at the age of 14/15. It was a raw and kicking techno sound with lots of energy and that was the perfect soundtrack for our personal revolution as teenager. Over the years we discovered all kinds of electronic music. Our favorite sounds are Dub techno, Detroit Techno, Electronica, Ambient or Downbeats and we try to reflect these influences in our productions. You could also hear it in our dj sets where we like to combine several styles with many waves, ups and downs and various emotions. In our opinion it's much more interesting than to play the same stuff for hours and nobody realizes that you play different songs.

I've noticed that you put a lot of attention in every detail of every sound, is that research a key point in the definition of your sound?

Yes, maybe thats one point. We love to work on details and try a lot of different ways to manipulate a sound. The best things always happening with little accidents and we try to capture it.

Can we talk about production? I think producers could use digital softwares in many ways, from a simple multitrack recorder to a creative piece of equipment, I would like to know in which way digital revolution influenced your creations.

The analog and the digital world are great and we think that you could get the best results if you use both together. Most times we start to jam with old drum machines and synthesizers from the 80ies and record them with modern production techniques from 2014. We cut and arrange everything with the computer. At the end we send the tracks to an analog mixer to do the final mixdown. This is our typical way of producing a song.

And what about the remix approach?

Its always fun to do remixes and special edits for our dj-sets. You could learn a lot if you listen carefuly and its nice to see how other producers work. If we do a remix then there has to be at least 3 or 4 really good elements or a great vocal which catches us. Today we finished a new remix for Steve Bug and he had some amazing synths inside. It was a lot of fun to built up our stuff around it.

As djs, is there any club, festival or situation that inspires you most? If not, when do you feel really inspired as a dj?

The most inspiring thing for us is to play at Panoramabar in Berlin because you could dig so deep into the sound and the people understand it. The sound system is amazing and the atmosphere is always something special.

Do you choose the records to bring with you just before the gig? Is there any specific way when you decide which tracks will you play?

We always prepare our record bag before a gig. Which record we put in the bag depends on how long we could play, at which time of the night we will play and if it's a big festival or a small club gig. I think you have to do different homework if you play a 1.5 hours peak time festival slot or if you play an after hour slot for 5 hours or more. What we play in a set depends of the crowd, the atmosphere, the energy and the right moment.

Do you like to define electronic music genres or do you feel that music can be heard without almost any sub-definition?

We are fans of an open mind attitude if it comes to music because all this subdefinition limits your creativity. If you have definitions then you have always borders and rules and this often keeps you away from discovering new and unexpected ways of combining music and ideas.

In the last years it seems that the physical music market (vinyls, cds) is rising up, is there any difference for you, as producers, between a physical copy, including artwork, graphic, tracklist, and a digital copy?

As a producer it's great if you could release your music as physical copy with a nice artwork. It feels better than to have just a MP3 file on a server. We love vinyl because we grew up with this culture. For Martin's solo album project youAND:THEMACHINES he wanted to do a nice packaging where he could give the vinyl and tape version of the album a unique touch. So he decided to paint each cover in a splash art way. It needed more then 2 months but we think it's worth to invest so much work because the result is something special. You could check the painting in this video:




Have you ever thought to release one LP as youANDme?

Yes, we thought about to produce an album as youANDme but I think it will need some time to find the right way to realize it.



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THE CLUBBER MIX 027: YOUAND: THEMACHINES

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youANDme is a project of Martin and Daniel and both live in Berlin / Germany. They work as DJs and producers since 1995. Both love the deeper side of music with many funk and soul, but every time raw and kicking. The structure of a youANDme set is very different; they like to play several styles in one set like house, techno, dub or electronica.

Martin and Daniel have published their tracks and mixes at labels like ORNAMENTS, COCOON, REKIDS, COMPOST, PLATZHIRSCH, REBIRTH, 2020VISION and many others.

youANDme are well known for their remixes and edits. They did official works for artists like Moodymann, Radio Slave, Seth Troxler, Lawrence, Brothers Vibe, Robert Owens, Timo Maas, Paul Johnson, Mark Broom, Kollektiv Turmstrasse, Johannes Heil, Florian Meindl, Pascal Feos or

A next step was the establishment of an own label and therefore youANDme created ROTARY COCKTAIL REC, POLYMORPH, CUTZ.ME and 3 other mysterious labels.

2009 was a successfull year because youANDme published some nice records and one highlight was the licencing of "Mind/Feeling" (youANDme Edit) to Sven Väth his "The Sound Of The 10th Season" live mix at Amnesia DVD (Cocoon Mix 027).

youANDme published their first official mix-cd "ORNAMENTS SYMPHONY" in 2010 and they got great reactions and press feedbacks like "ALBUM OF THE MONTH" or "DE:BUG 2010 - OUR RECORDS OF THE YEAR" at the important german "DE:BUG" magazine. The youANDme record "I LIKE" was also "SINGLE OF THE MONTH" at the "DE:BUG" magazine in June 2010.



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2011 started with a release for the COCOON label of SVEN VÄTH, a remix for MOODYMANN on ORNAMENTS and 4 remixes for RADIO SLAVE on REKIDS & CUTZ.ME. The remix for Moodymann was "RECORD OF THE MONTH (HOUSE)" [05/11] and a remix for Rhauder was "RECORD OF THE MONTH (TECHNO)" [08/11] at the german RAVELINE magazine.

2012 was the year of the album production of Martin's solo project youAND:THEMACHINES and he had spent every free minute in the studio to finish the "BEHIND" LP which will be published as ORNAMENTS 027 (06/2013). Furthermore youANDme did remixes for KOLLEKTIV TURMSTRASSE or JOHANNES HEIL and they released a record on the Detroit based label DEEPLABS.

Martin Müller a.k.a youand:THEMACHINES done special 100% vinyl mix for The Clubber and we talked with him about his music career, what you can read in the interview below.

The Clubber: So could you tell us, how did you decide to go solo under youand:THEMACHINES and what's the difference working alone and along side in youANDme?

Martin: My solo project is called "youAND:THEMACHINES" and I produced the "BEHIND" LP which was released on the Ornaments imprint in June, 2013. Daniel had finished his architecture studies 3 years ago and is now working 9 to 5 in his job. He is focussing on his career as an architect and thats why there is not much time for studio work at the moment. That's the reason we both decided that I do the album as solo project under the new name youAND:THEMACHINES. At first it was a foreign feeling but then I realized more and more that I have the freedom to express myself in a more personal way. It was great to make music alone and I think the result is different than our other works. When I finished the album I was happy that Daniel really liked the result.

The Clubber: Your last years debut album on Ornament Records came out really good, and now you have the remix of LP coming in May, with names such as Steve Bug, Matthew Herbert, Legowelt, Youandewan, Boo Williams, and others, even your partner Daniel have a rework done. Can you tell us your thoughts on whole project, both last years and the remixes?

Martin: For my long player debut I wanted to create an album that brings together my different influences like dub techno, ambient, downbeats, Detroit techno or house. The album was created during a period of 2 years and the production process was not every time easy but at the end it was so much fun to do it. One of the main concepts of the "BEHIND" LP was to create the most sounds with plenty of analogue hardware or field recordings from my personal environment. It was forbidden to use sampling as sound source.

The remix album is called "BEHIND" LP RESHAPED and it will be an opulent collection of selected edits, interpretations and remixes courtesy of a prestigious roster of my favorite producers including Matthew Herbert, Steve Bug, XDB, Boo Williams, Sascha Dive, Legowelt, Marko Fürstenberg & Luke Hess, Carlos Nilmmns, Youandewan, Rising Sun,The Analog Roland Orchestra, Jamie 3:26, Freund der Familie, Basic Soul Unit and youANDme (Daniel). The "BEHIND" LP RESHAPED will come bolstered with labour-of-love extras including 333 hand-painted artwork editions (3 x 12") with each cover bearing a unique painting and stamped number and a special limited tape edition again, with hand-painted artwork and a bonus exclusive tape track.



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THE CLUBBER MIX 027: YOUAND: THEMACHINES

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The Clubber: What's your criteria when you are producing and main goal that you are trying to achieve? We've heard that most of tracks that you made are produced on Moog Voyager, Roland Alpha Juno and Roland drum machines. Can you tell us why do you prefer analog equipment?

Martin: I really love the sound aesthetics of the analogue stuff. It's warm, fat, and a little bit dirty. If you play a loop for example it's never exact the same sound which makes it more natural. Maybe you could do the same with a computer but the most important fact for me is the interaction with real machines. You can play it, touch it and for me the results are more interesting.

Most times I start to jam with old drum machines and synthesizers and record them with modern production techniques. I cut and arrange everything with the computer. At the end I send the tracks to an analog mixer to do the final mixdown. This is my typical way of producing a song.

The Clubber: So what's up next? New projects, EP's, something under youANDme?

Martin: At the moment we are focussed on the remix album of my "Behind" LP which will be released on ORNAMENTS in May. We are also working on a new youANDme EP and a new MIX CD for the tenth birthday of ROTARY COCKTAIL REC. Last week we finished a remix for Steve Bug which will be out soon on Pokerflat.

The Clubber: And where do you find inspiration, and who do you cherish the most from your colleagues?

Martin: There are so many great artists out there which I really love but if I have to name a few who had inspired me the most I would say Matthew Herbert, Carl Craig, Moritz von Oswald and Mark Ernestus.










16 reworks for Martin Müller's Behind LP will see release on vinyl and cassette in May.



youAND:THEMACHINES is an alias of Martin Müller, otherwise known as half the Berlin duo youANDme, and Behind, which came out last June, was his debut solo LP. A press release describes the contributors to Behind Reshaped as some of Müller's favorite producers, and indeed, an all-star roster of house and techno talent fills out the tracklist.

Poker Flat boss Steve Bug and Deep Vibes man Sascha Dive have been recruited, and youANDme themselves will turn in a rework as well. Also on board are the likes of Dutch favorite Legowelt and Duel—the Leipzig-meets-Detroit duo of Marko Fürstenberg and Luke Hess—along with Matthew Herbert, Boo Williams and Basic Soul Unit. Two reworks will come from another Berlin duo, Freund Der Familie, one of which will appear only on the cassette version. Altogether, there will be 15 tracks on a triple-vinyl pack limited to 333 copies, and 16 put on a run of 150 tapes. For both versions, each cover will feature hand-painted artwork and a stamped number.



"No neighbourhood is rough enough", rappte Genius GZA. "Weder zur Furcht noch zur Hoffnung besteht Grund, sondern nur dazu, neue Waffen zu suchen", schrieb Gilles Deleuze.

Trotzdem fühlt es sich unwirklich an. Die De:Bug verkörpert für mich nicht nur den Rückzug in den Underground am Zenit des Massen-Rave (Stichwort: Frontpage-Abgang) und das Ende der Eindeutigkeit, sondern auch bis zum Schluss den Versuch, doch das richtige im falschen Leben zu führen – (musikalische) Horizonterweiterung, true spirit, Detroit und Selbstbeherrschung inklusive. Ihm, und als Ausblick, dass die letzte Bassdrum noch lange nicht aufgelegt ist, widme ich diese letzte Review. "Sansula", der Ruhepol auf Martin Müllers Debütalbum wird in den Händen der Basic Soul Unit zum überdrehten Intro, das nur darauf wartet, in einem Club zu explodieren. Kosta XDBs "Perception" huldigt der Handclap in ungewohnt-stampfender Stand-Up-for-Detroit-Manier. Auch The Analog Roland Orchestra entdeckt eine neue Seite an sich und schüttelt mal nebenbei ein Boards-of-Canadaeskes "Desire" in mondscheinschönster Melancholie aus den Geräten. Herbert setzt zum großen Schlag an und lässt "Uncover" Dancefloor-zermürbend, Wishmountain-mäßig dahinklappern, als ob 1997 im Omen nie zu Ende gegangen wäre. Legowelts "Domain Specific" klingt gewohnt souverän in seiner mythologisch-verschwörerischen Analog-Art. Weitere Tracks veredeln youANDme, Boo Williams, Marko Fürstenberg & Luke Hess, Youandewan, Jamie 3:26 und Carlos Nilmmns, Neben der handbemalten Triple-12" wird das exzellente Album auch als Kassette erscheinen - for those who know. Danke für die schöne Zeit und die grandiose Musik. Rave on.

Behind LP Reshaped

Antes de mais, há que sublinhar, em Behind LP Reshaped, a característica que o coloca à frente dos semelhantes: aqui está um disco de remisturas que se consegue superiorizar ao álbum do qual extrai matéria (o já de si imponente Behind, de youAND:THEMACHINES). Quantos objectos do género poderão reclamar o mesmo título? Não se cansem a erguer a segunda mão para contá-los. Além disso, Behind LP Reshaped consegue fazer-nos pensar que remisturar um tema não difere muito de preparar um gin tónico: o produtor que dispõe da melhor água tónica consegue geralmente convencer-nos de que o gin é de primeira qualidade (quando pode até não ser). Isso não significa no entanto que Behind, na sua forma original, fosse disco para andar perdido nas prateleiras mais pobrezinhas da pior loia de conveniência. Nem por sombras.

A Ornaments, que o lançou no ano passado, fez questão de que Behind não passasse despercebido e concedeu-lhe o luxo de uma edição em triplo-doze polegadas, com direito a ser pintado e numerado à mão Por aqui não andámos a dormir e pegámos nesse álbum precisamente pelo que tem de bom: uma tremenda elegância house, que não será de todo estranha ao facto de YouAND:THEMACHINES (Martin Müller, se preferirem) tantas vezes recorrer a recorrer a instrumentos analógicos (Moog, Roland), em vez de ficar retido na mais fria redoma digital. Pois bem, o disco de transformações, Behind LP Reshaped, conhece agora um tratamento equivalente ao original e aí está em mais uma gloriosa edição artesanal em formato de triplo-doze polegadas. Mudaram apenas as cores e agora os salpicos são brancos e o fundo é totalmente negro.



O imenso negro, que Reshaped traz na capa, adequa-se perfeitamente à tonalidade das remisturas que inclui (e aqui diríamos até que as malhas preveem o mesmo futuro fascinante, ainda que sombrio dos filmes de Luc Besson e Ridley Scott). Logo ao abrir faltam-nos as palayras para a bênção deep que a dupla Freund der Familie (em clara ascensão da curva) garante a "Entrance" transformando-a na muito mais hermética "Entrance Room". Os Freund der Familie voltam mais adiante com "Inner Connected" (aposta espectaculamente ganha num sample ínfimo do original) e então passa a ser impossível deixar de reparar que Behind LP Reshaped é também um triunfo deles.

Igualmente triunfantes são as participações de Matthew Herbert e de Legowelt, que tornam o terceiro vinil no mais ardente de todo o conjunto. O primeiro surge em modo de diversão total e para nós é uma alegria descansarmos do Herbert mais conceptual. Legowelt por sua vez confirma o óptimo momento de forma e não deixa que o disco de remisturas termine sem o momento de trance "em altas", que marca também um dos auges deste Reshaped. Nem todos os gins tónicos da rodada são tão aconselháveis, mas, em geral, Behind LP Reshaped oferece garantias de uma óptima embriaguez sonora.











the remix album is a curious entity. Unless the project has an acutely refined curation and the artist has a natural synergy with their drafted in peers, they lose the narrative and flow that connects a contiguous work, left to fall back on the lucky dip which makes up the supporting cast. Here we find Martin Müller's solo departure as youAND: THEMACHINES run through this treatment, whose original work on Behind was as refined and dubby as the smoky vinyl it came pressed on.

Ibiza

Behind Reshaped, at first, hits the holy ground of context and consistency. Starting from the top with Entrance Room, Freund der Familie's dark dub march deftly drops the meaty kick over the break to let the atmosphere smoulder before Marko Fürstenberg & Luke Hess pick up the baton on The Veil, fanning the embers to provide a more vibrant glow. It is at this point the first sidestep occurs - XDB's touch on Perception heads into the oft forgotten Wild Pitch sound before Basic Soul Unit rolls out a shadowy and piston driven version of Sansula.

Darkness is then cast aside as youandewan, who is no relation to the youAND: THEMACHINES projects, steps up to the controls. Living up to its title, his dub of Diamond shines with multifaceted light, full of dreamy organs and sprightly 909's. After that, fans of Steve Bug's remix of Will Saul & Tam Cooper's Where Is It? will be pleased to see the German stalwart hit the same form on Drift, rolling out a tribalesque production that is keenly suited to Bajka's spoken word monologue that drifts over the top.

So far so good, but it is at this halfway spot the only real misstep happens. Tackling the mournful violin led ${f Desire},$ ${\it Rising Sun's two}$

part treatment begs to be segued into one continuous piece and the Analogue Orchestra's downtempo touch feels more like a closing reprise than a standalone entry. Still, hot house-y form returns with Boo Williams' sparkling chi-town rub on Desire, which offers a sprightlier and more emotional alternative to Bug's subtly deep interpretation. Jamie 3:26's dub of Sway is surging and fluid but quickly swatted from view as it is blindsided by the mercurial Matthew Herbert, who contorts Uncover into a twisted and squealing piece of compah technologies.

Suffering the same fate as Jamie 3:26, who are both unfortunate enough to be perched on the shoulders of giants, Sascha Dive's soulful take on Inner Connected is more than enough to hypnotise dancefloors, but has its thunder stolen when critics favourite, Danny Wolfers in Legowelt guise, slides in to treat Domain Specific to a thunderous and reverential techno workout.

Closing this mammoth collection, Martin teams up with production partner Daniel Stroeter to take Beyond down a dark and progressive path as youANDme, while Carlos Nilmmn's orchestral version strays ever so slightly too close to sounding like a backing piece of mood music for an Elder Scrolls game.

As an end to end listen, the tracklist is exhausting. To listen to as an album, Behind Reshaped would probably need the editing scissors to snip the duration down to two 12"s, perhaps drafting in Freund der Familie's additional and cassette tape only re-dub of Inner Connected in place of the few stragglers present. However, this flaw, if you can call an abundance of material a flaw, is something that is inherent to the remix album format, its strength also being its one weakness. As such, for the DJ or the pick and chooser amongst us, the sheer wealth of material is a boon, with many solid highlights with which to arm and intriguing curios to indulge a tangent.

Se cumple un año del álbum debut en solitario del germano Martin Müller mitad desde 1995 del dúo berlinés youANDme- en Ornaments. Aquel Behind ha sido pasado ahora por la turbomix de varios artistas bastante conocidos: Legowelt, Matthew Herbert, Steve Bug, Boo Williams... Así hasta culminar dieciséis nombres. El resultado como te puedes imaginar les ha quedado de lo más heterogéneo.

El disco arranca con sobriedad y dub techno, Entrance Room (Freund der Familie remix). Klaus y Mirko nos firman una de sonambulismo electrónico y colchones llenos de profundidad. Casi calcado el remix que los mismos Freund der Familie infringen a Inner Connected, en todo caso una pizca más orgánico. Similar aventura pero mucho más techno, oscura y dinámica la que emprenden Marko Fürstenberg y Luke Hess con The Veil. La voz tenebrosa de Keter Darker ayudará no sabes como a dar esa sensación que comentaba de nebulosa misteriosa. Más luminosa y melódica resulta Sway bajo el lavado de cara de Jamie 3:26. Este señor del underground dance de Chicago nos regala un fenomenal tira y afloja entre groove y Detroit techno volador. Entra solo.

Entre los ilustres que participan en este LP me gustaría destacar a dos: Legowelt y Matthew Herbert. En ambos casos se les reconoce a la perfección. El holandés se las ingenia con Domain Specific, suena a puto cacharro. No podía ser de otro modo. Me ha transportado por un rato a aquel techno-trance de los 90 con unas gotas justas de acid y otras de abstracción: Marmion, LSG, Cygnus X... Una maravilla que en vinilo incluso nos sonará a gloria. Mientras tanto Herbert se divierte entrecortando vocales y demás elementos en un cargado corte de electro house. Me desdigo un poco, la verdad es que es un poco más punzante de lo habitual en él.
